Please understand that our priority is the safety of our students and staff, and then communication with our parents if permitted by the first responders, whose protocols may be to secure all communications when they arrive on scene. Who Can Join? All students interested in technology, hacking, and cybersecurity are welcome! No experience is needed.


Why Join? Cybersecurity is one of the fastest-growing career fields. Joining our club is a great way to learn valuable skills and discover a possible career path!
















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SPOKANE NATIONAL GOLLEGE FAIR
